ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

These minimum criteria are evaluated during initial screenings of each program applicant. Each program uses additional evaluation methods during the months of January and February. Applicants will receive further communication from each Program Specialist, as appropriate, to indicate offer/acceptance status.

- 1. Academic achievement in middle school, to include:
- · Grades
- · Standardized test scores
- · Scholastic Reading Index (SRI)/Lexile scores
- 2. Demonstrated interest and motivation for learning:
- · Report card comments
- · Teacher endorsements
- · School and community involvement (Activity List)
- 3. Strong written communication skills: essay component



Additional, program-specific requirements:

Natural Resources and Agricultural Sciences (NRAS) Information Technology Oracle Academy (ITOA)

· Algebra 1 recommended, not required.

Science and Mathematics Academy (SMA)

· Successful completion of Algebra 1 and *Geometry prior to entering the program. *Geometry can be taken in the summer prior to ninth grade.

Global Studies/International Baccalaureate (GSIB or IB)

- · Successful completion of Algebral prior to entering program.
- · Strongly recommend successful completion of Geometry. *Geometry can be taken in the summer prior to ninth grade.

Harford Technical High School (HT Trades)

· See application for program-specific requirements.



FAQ ANSWERED



If I need guidance accessing the application, who can I ask?

- Refer to the Guide to the Application.
- Schedule time with your School Counselor for assistance.



Can I apply to more than one program?

- Yes. You may apply for up to 3 programs.
- Only 1 of 3 applications may be for a Harford Tech program.



What if I change my mind and want to withdraw my application?

• You may retract your application online.



How do I know if my application(s) has been received?

 All information regarding your application will be communicated via email. Set your email to accept messages from webmaster@hcps.org as well as the Program Specialists to avoid messages going to Spam.



Can I fax/email/post mail my application?

• No. All applications will be submitted via the online portal.



How do I obtain teacher endorsements?

• The online application will automatically populate and email your teachers AFTER you submit a completed application.



If accepted, can I still participate in extra- and co-curricular activities

Yes. You are fully immersed in the school community.

FAQ ANSWERED continued

- How can I improve my chances of being accepted into a Magnet program?
 - Ensure your application is complete, your essay is well-written, and you put forth your best effort in middle school.
- 9 I receive accomodations through an IEP or 504 Plan. Am I eligible?
 Yes.
- I am currently on Home/Hospital Teaching. Am I eligible?Yes.
- How will I find out about transportation?

If I enroll in a Magnet and dislike it, can I switch programs?

• Magnet Programs are a 4-year commitment. Students are not permitted to move between programs, but may elect to withdraw from the Magnet and return to their community schools.


If a Magnet is available at two or more sites, can I choose the location?

- No, you are applying to a program, not a school. For programs
 offered in multiple locations, seats are assigned at random.
 - What are my options if I am not accepted into a Magent?
 - You may enroll in any of the CTE programs offered in your community school, including the Youth Apprenticeship and Workforce Investment programs.

Visit www.hcps.org -->Students tab --> Student Planner OR Schools > Magnet Programs > Application Non-HCPS users will be prompted to create an account.






HCPS Students: Your information will autofill. Verify it is correct or make edits.

Non-HCPS Students: Carefully and accurately enter all information to create your profile.

- You can access your application until 11:59 pm on December 5th.
- Within your account, you can withdraw your application if you change your mind.
- Contact your School Counselor for assistance.

GUIDE TO THE APPLICATION continued

You can <u>SAVE</u> your application and work on it over time.
But remember to return to and <u>SUBMIT</u> it before the deadline.



- TEACHER ENDORSEMENTS

 HCPS students: Your teachers will autofill the application.

 Non-HCPS students: Manually enter teacher contact information.

 The teacher endorsement is valid for all Programs to which you apply.
- Submit a bulleted ACTIVITY LIST by December 5th.
 This list only needs to be submitted once and is active for all programs to which you apply.
 - Once you SUBMIT an Activity List, you cannot make changes to it.
- Each Magnet program you select will ask you to write an ESSAY.
 Each essay must be submitted by December 5th.
 Once you submit your essay, you cannot make changes to it.
- Click "Submit Application." You may then return to the Home Page to apply to another program.
 - You may apply to a maximum of 3 programs.
 Each application must be completed individually.
 For Harford Tech choose ONE technical program.
 For NRAS rank your pathways in order of preference.




