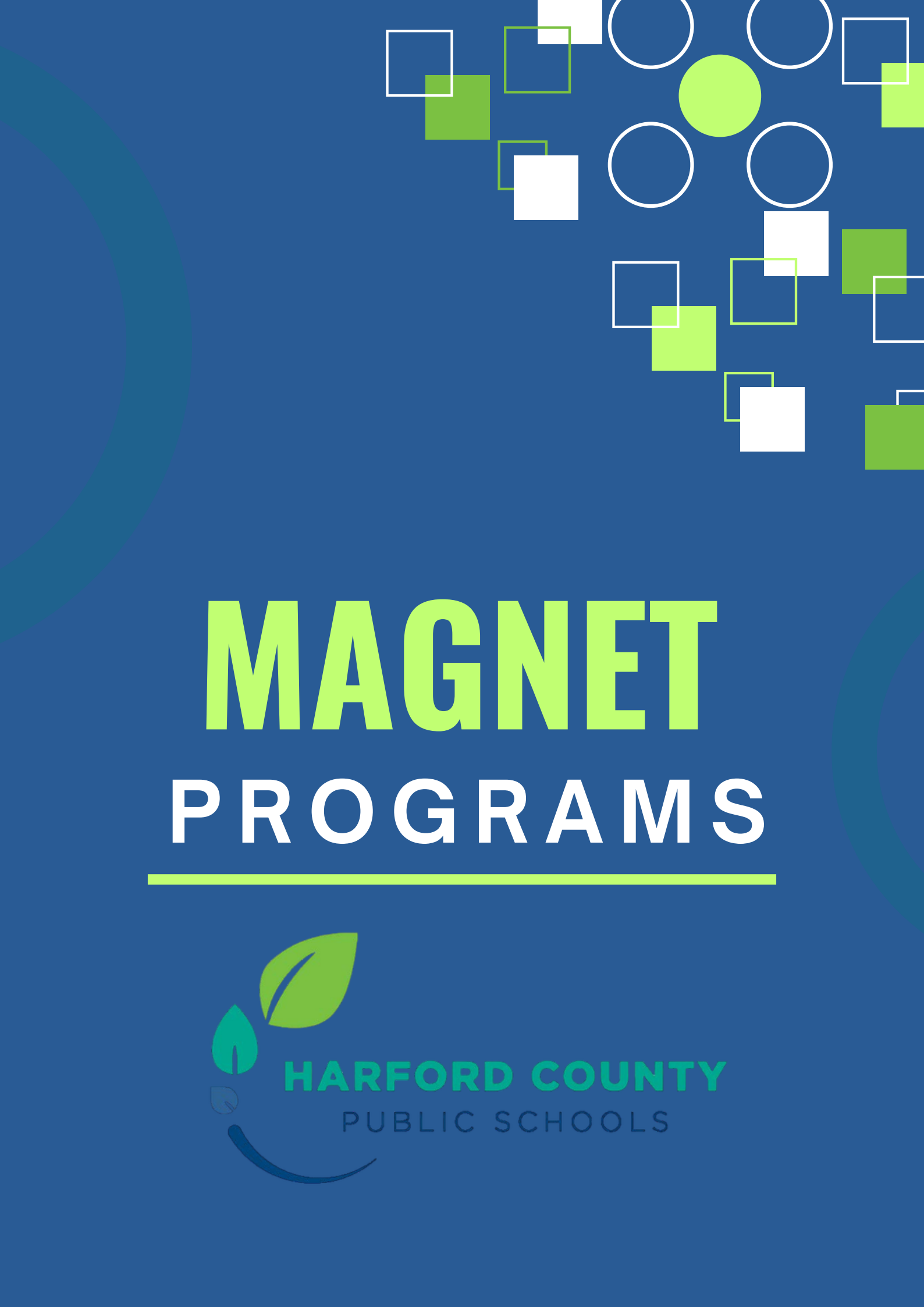

- Declined seats will be offered to waitlisted applicants.





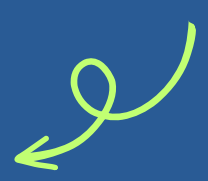
ADMISSION CRITERIA

Students may apply to a total of three Magnet Programs.
For Harford Tech, choose only one program.

Applicants will receive further communication from each
Program Specialist, as appropriate, to indicate
offer/acceptance status.



Academic achievement and performance in middle school

1. Grades
 2. Standardized test scores
 3. Scholastic Reading Index (SRI)/Lexile scores
 4. Attendance rate

FAQ ANSWERED

If I need guidance accessing the application, who can I ask?

- Schedule time with your School Counselor for assistance.

2

Can I apply to more than one program?

- Yes. You may apply for up to 3 programs.
- Only 1 of 3 applications may be for a Harford Tech program.

3

What if I change my mind and want to withdraw my application?

- You may retract your application online in the portal.

4

How do I know if my application(s) has been received?

- All information regarding your application will be communicated via email. Set your email to accept messages from webmaster@hcps.org as well as the Program Specialists to avoid messages going to Spam.

5

Can I fax/email/postmail my application?

- No. All applications will be submitted via the online portal.

6

How do I obtain teacher endorsements?

- The online application will automatically populate and email your teachers AFTER you submit a completed application.

7

If accepted, can I still participate in extra- and co-curricular activities

- Yes. You are fully immersed in the school community.

8 How can I improve my chances of being accepted?

- Ensure your application is complete and authentically represents you as a learner.

9 I receive accommodations through an IEP or 504 Plan. Am I eligible?

- Yes, and services will continue as described in your plan.

10 I am currently on Home/Hospital Teaching. Am I eligible?

- Yes.

11 How will I find out about transportation?

- Bus details will be shared in August.

12 If I enroll in a Magnet and dislike it, can I switch programs?

- No, but you may elect to return to your neighborhood school.

13 If a Magnet is offered at two or more sites, can I choose the location?

- No, you are applying to a program, not a school. For programs offered in multiple locations, seats are assigned at random.

14 What are my options if I am not accepted into a Magnet?

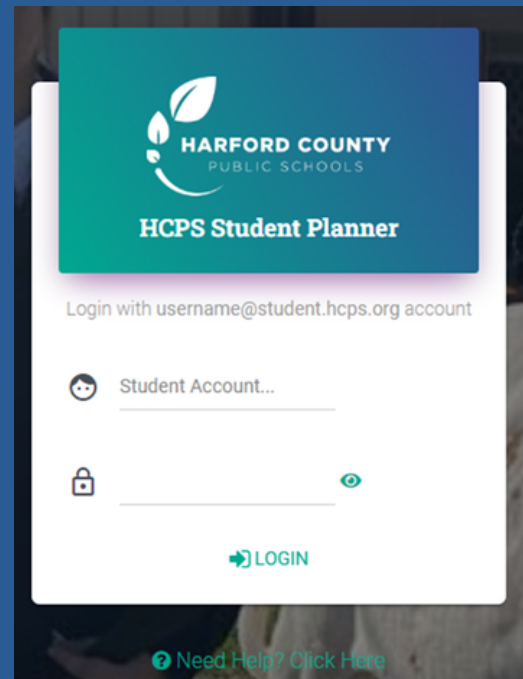
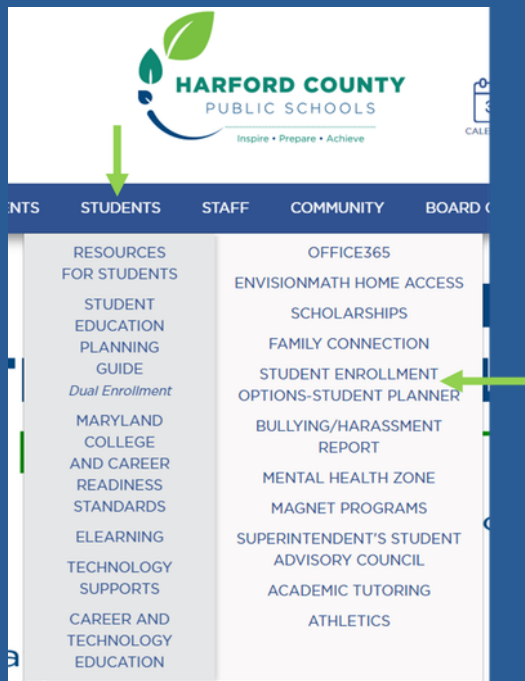
- You may enroll in any of the CTE programs offered in your neighborhood school.

TEACHER ENDORSEMENTS

HCPS students: Your teachers will autopopulate in the application based on the Magnet you chose.

Non-HCPS students: Accurately enter teacher contact information.

ACTIVITY LIST

Submit a bulleted list.

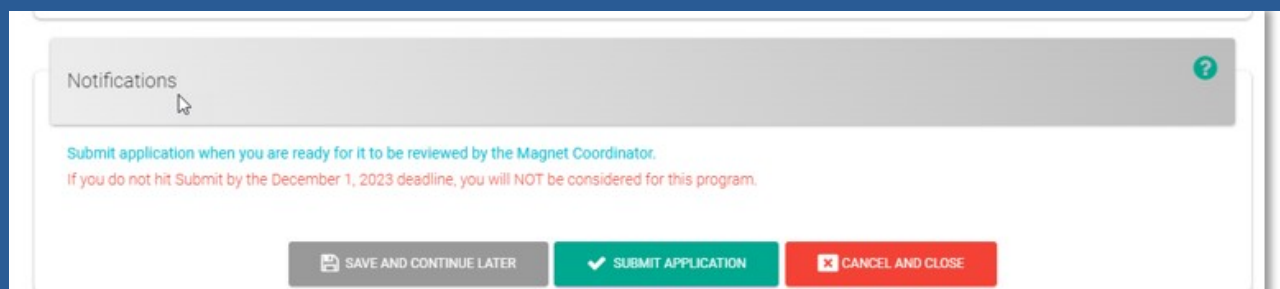
- This list only needs to be submitted once and is active for all programs to which you apply.
- Once you SUBMIT an Activity List, you cannot make changes to it.

OPEN-ENDED PROMPT and RESPONSE

- Applicants will choose and respond to ONE prompt.
- This response will be applied to any and all applications.

SAVING and SUBMITTING

You can SAVE your application and work on it over time. But remember to return to and SUBMIT it before the deadline.
