<h2>Graduation Requirements</h2>	
Requirements for graduation from a Maryland Public High School are listed below. Students must earn a minimum of 26 credits in Grades 9 through 12 to receive a Maryland High School Diploma from Harford County Public Schools.	
Subject Area	Specific Credit Requirements
English	4 Credits
Mathematics	4 credits, including Algebra and Geometry. <b>Must be enrolled in a mathematics course in each year of high school</b> ( <i>maximum of 4 years of attendance, unless in the 5th or 6th year a mathematics course is needed to meet a graduation requirement</i> )
Science	3 Credits including Biology
Social Studies	3 Credits including US History, American Government and World History
Fine Art	1 Credit
Phys Ed	1 Credit including Foundations of Fitness and Physical Activity
Health	1 Credit (.5 in 9 <sup>th</sup> and .5 in 10 <sup>th</sup> )
Technology	1 Credit of Foundations of Technology <b>or</b> AP Computer Science Principles
Completer Program Requirements	2-4 Credits 4 credits in an approved Career & Technology Education (CTE) Career Completer Program Or 2 credits of same World Language + University Systems of Maryland (USM) requirements (4 years of math including Algebra II or beyond in the senior year).
