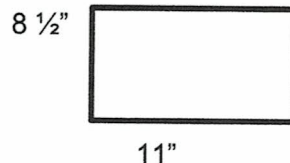

- a. Posters must be in landscape format which is 8 ½" high by 11" wide.

 - c. Any artistic medium may be used. Graphic design computer programs are permitted.
 - d. No licensed characters (Disney, etc.) may be used. Any clip art or stock images used must be free and not copyrighted.
 - e. All entries **MUST** display the **REALTOR®** and **Fair Housing logos** (found below) **AND** the theme, "**Fair Housing Opens Doors**", somewhere in the body of the piece.
 - f. All entries must be labeled on the back. (Attached to this packet are forms that must be completed for every entry.)
