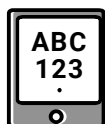

Investments in Harford County

Our COVID-19 Fund has raised more than \$2.7 million dollars (to date) and, in our first round of funding, **26 organizations were located in Harford County and/or serving those living in Harford County.**

Harford County Public Schools received three grants:



\$24,000 grant to purchase iPads for pre-K students



\$6,000 grant to support a before-school tutoring program



\$2,000 grant for mental health programming for families



The Boys & Girls Clubs of Harford County **received 200 devices** to ensure continued learning



United Way of Central Maryland provided support **to more than 25 families** in Title One schools through our Family Stability program

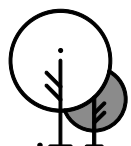
