

HCPS OPERATIONS STATUS

AS OF JULY 7, 2021

This information will be updated as HCPS recovery efforts evolve, and the COVID-19 crisis changes.



- Schools, offices, transportation, and food and nutrition services operational for all.
- Supervisors direct work for employees including in-person essential and remote responsibilities.
- **Vaccinations encouraged by CDC, State of Maryland, Harford County Health Department, and HCPS.**



- Masks are optional on HCPS property. Masks are required on school buses per a federal order.
- Visitor appointments preferred.
- Volunteers allowed with administrator approval.
- Social activities, such as staff lunches and celebrations, approved for employees.*
- “Use of Facilities” applications are available for all event types, with indoor “Use of Facilities” dates for outside organizations available beginning July 19th. Outside organizations must follow their own COVID-19 protocols during the use of HCPS facilities, such as enforcement of quarantine/isolation, handwashing, and cleaning of high touch surfaces and shared materials.
- Fall Operational Status under review and awaiting CDC and MSDE updates.

**Reminder - Isolation/quarantine for COVID-19 exposures still apply.*



- No person with COVID-19 symptoms, in isolation due to a positive COVID-19 test, in quarantine due to close contact with a person with COVID-19 symptoms or a COVID-19 positive test, or in quarantine for any reason may work in or visit HCPS property.
- All wishing to enter HCPS property must adhere to their isolation or quarantine timeline as directed by HCPS Health Services in consultation with their personal health care physician, the Harford County Health Department, the Maryland Department of Healthand/or any Governor’s order.
