Dublin Elementary SGA Sponsored Scholarship

The Dublin Elementary School SGA Scholarship was created to recognize a former Dublin Elementary School student planning to continue their education with a college or university. One scholarship will be awarded this year for \$1,000, to a Harford County student who meets the criteria of eligibility and submits all documents with the completed application by the specified deadline.

Eligibility and Requirements:

1. Applicant must be an HCPS senior in high school.
2. Applicant must have attended Dublin for at least two full years (grade level).
3. Applicant must provide a sealed transcript from their high school counselor with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 unweighted.
5. Applicant must complete the scholarship application.
6. Applicant must complete a resume that includes extracurricular and community activities, awards/honors, etc.
7. Applicants must write an essay describing how Dublin Elementary School shaped you to become who you are today and prepared you to further your education beyond high school. Please use our Dublin motto PROUD in your essay. P is for perseverance, R is for respect, O is for own it, U is for use integrity, and D is discipline.
8. Applicant must provide one letter of recommendation, from a non-family member.

Scholarship Application Process:

Scholarship application, a letter of recommendation, resume, and essay will be judged by a panel that includes members of the DUES faculty. The panel will review all information supplied with the application, including GPA, however, greater emphasis is placed on the essay and resume. Only applications with all required materials included will be accepted and presented to the panel. Applications may be mailed, or hand delivered to the DUES School Administrative Assistant, Mrs. Melissa Dinan.

The scholarship recipient will be notified by phone and email.

Materials can be hand delivered by May 8, 2026. If materials are mailed, all materials should be put in one envelope and postmarked by May 8, 2026, and mailed to:
