### **Board of Education of Harford County Welcomes Two New Members**

Harford County Public Schools is pleased to announce the appointment of Mrs. BangTam Miller and the election of a new Student Member of the Board, Vibha Nanduri, to the Board of Education of Harford County. Mrs. Miller fills the seat vacated by Mark Korn, who resigned in April 2026. Mrs. Miller was sworn in by the county clerk on May 13, 2026. She will be seated at the next Board of Education meeting on Monday, May 18, 2026.

Mrs. Miller is a 51-year resident of Harford County. She was born in Vietnam and her family immigrated to the United States in 1975. Mrs. Miller and her six siblings attended Edgewood schools and graduated from Edgewood High School. In 2017 she and her siblings, known as the “Dang Seven” were inducted into Edgewood High School's Hall of Fame.

Mrs. Miller retired from Harford County Public Schools after a 26-year career, having served as a teacher, a mentor, a recruiter, an Assistant Principal, and in Central Office as the Accountability Coordinator and Human Resources Compliance and Labor Relations Specialist. Mrs. Miller holds a Master's in Curriculum and Instruction from McDaniel College, a Bachelor's in Elementary Education from Towson University, and an Associate of Arts in Education from Harford Community College. During her tenure, Mrs. Miller served as a STEM Master Teacher for Maryland's Educator Effectiveness Academy and as an adjunct instructor for the College of Notre Dame Teacher Prep Program. In 2010, she represented Harford County at Taiwan's National Educator Conference.

Mrs. Miller is a small business owner and founder of the 755 Alliance nonprofit organization. She has received the Local Management Board's Champion of Children Award, Harford County's Most Beautiful People Ripple Effect Award, the Baltimore Sun's 25 Women to Watch recognition, and was a finalist for the Athena Organizational Leadership Award.

“I welcome Mrs. BangTam Miller to the Board of Education of Harford County,” said Board of Education of Harford County President Lauren Paige. “Her first-hand knowledge of what it takes to work in our schools at nearly every level will be a benefit to the Board. I look forward to working with both Mrs. Miller, and our soon-to-be Student Member of the Board, Vibha Nanduri, in the important work of ensuring our students get the best education possible!”

experience as an HCPS educator, and her passion for service make her an outstanding addition to the Board. We also congratulate Vibha Nanduri on her election as Student Member of the Board and look forward to the perspective and voice she will bring on behalf of students across Harford County."

Vibha Nanduri, a junior at Bel Air High School, was elected as the 2026-2027 Student Member of the Board by her peers at the Harford County Region of the Association of Student Councils General Assembly meeting at C. Milton Wright High School. Vibha is enrolled in the Bel Air High School Biomedical Sciences program and currently serves as the First Vice President of Harford County Regional Association of Student Councils (HCRASC) and the Environmental Affairs Coordinator for the Maryland Association of Student Councils. She has advocated in Annapolis to increase statewide education funding through the Maryland Blueprint and has been a frequent speaker during public comments at Board of Education meetings. Vibha's term will begin July 1, 2026, and continue through June 30, 2027.
