Edgewood High School's Global International Baccalaureate Magnet Celebrates Exceptional Class of 2026 Results

Edgewood High School's Global International Baccalaureate (IB) Magnet Program is proud to celebrate the outstanding achievements of its graduating Class of 2026, whose academic performance continues the program's tradition of excellence and global-minded scholarship.

The Class of 2026 achieved an impressive 79.4% IB Diploma pass rate, reflecting the dedication, resilience, and hard work of students and staff throughout the rigorous International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. The achievement comes as the International Baccalaureate reported a global Diploma Programme pass rate of 82.61% for the May 2026 assessment session.

Among this year's highlights, Darien A., earned a perfect score of 7 in IB English Literature Higher Level, and Alianyz Martinez, earned a 7 in IB Spanish Standard Level. These are exceptional accomplishments that reflect the high academic standards and commitment to excellence within the program.

The Class of 2026 also posted remarkable subject-area results, including:

- 100% pass rate in English
- 100% pass rate in Psychology
- 100% pass rate in French
- 97% pass rate in Theory of Knowledge (ToK)
- 92% pass rate in World Religions
- 91.5% pass rate in Geography SL/HL

"The accomplishments of Edgewood High School's International Baccalaureate students reflect the exceptional opportunities the IB Program provides for students to engage in rigorous, globally focused learning," said Dr. Dyann R.
